1.2 Highlights

- 1. The college, in cooperation with local communities, government, and private agencies implemented 13 projects in the last academic year of 2020 as to support students to adhere to morality, ethics and desirable values. This motivated students to become moral, ethical, and desirable graduates. In addition, the college received the Outstanding Organization Assessment Award of first runner-up, gold medal for the medium-sized college, Northeastern Region level year 2020 at Academic Conference of the Organization of Future Professionals of Thailand Professional and Basic Skills Competition Northeastern Region Level 30th Academic Year 2020 at Buriram Vocational Education Office and rank standard of the Association of Future Professionals from year 2020 in the academic year 2021.
- 2. College implemented projects to take care of students and to help reduce dropout problems, such projects were Student-Teacher-Parent Relation Project, a SMIS project for student monitoring, House Visiting, as a result, the dropout rate reduced and the graduation rate increased to 82.42%.
- 3. The college managed its services; community service, academic service, profession service, and volunteer with cooperation and participation from its management, teachers, educational personnel, and students. This encouraged students to volunteer their professions to benefit communities and society through 5 projects in the academic year 2021.

4.The college gave precedence to the development of high-speed Internet system management, information and database management for school administration, and for comprehensive use of information within the college benefiting to students. It developed and improved network system by defining a password for school's Internet access as to protect and secure data storage and use. All classrooms and laboratories could be connected to high-speed Internet.

5.The college provided Dual Vocational Education Program for both levels Vocational Certificate (Voc. Cert.) in 2 fields of study and High Vocational Certificate (Dip./High Voc. Cert.) in 9 fields of study. It had well cooperated with enterprises to provide Dual Vocational Education Program. As a result, students apprenticed their profession that match their field of study.

- 6. College improved and maintained perfect environment, landscape, buildings, classrooms, laboratories, and various learning resources which always received good feedbacks from outside people for having such as a beautiful and shady landscape, accommodating to learning environment. It also maintained effective management on the electrical system, water supply and security system.
- 7. The college encouraged participation of all departments to take part in the preparation of professional standardized exams, both theoretical and practical, also standardized exams from vocational education in Nong Khai Province by appointing a committee to assess professional standards, organizing an Assessment Tool Development Workshop Project, Vocational Qualifications (VQ) Project. As a result, the organizations, agencies and stakeholders accepted the college for producing qualified profession students.

- 8. Teachers developed learning plans with focus on learners and implemented the plans to classes, managed classes by creating individual student information, used a variety of teaching techniques to promote a learning atmosphere as well as get participation in school administration.
- 9. The college drove to have enough teachers for learners according to standards of the Office of Vocational Education Commission, supervised and supported teachers to meet their qualifications. Organized a project to develop teaching professional skills, encouraged teachers to pursue higher education, organized training and seminar.
- 10. The college owned capable executives who have knowledge and the ability to manage education according to the policy of the Office of Vocational Education Commission. They shared and published news and policies to teachers, staff, educational personnel, communities, parents, government and private agencies. They managed the college by having good cooperation and participation from both internal and external personnel.

- 5. The colleges should establish collaborative networks with other establishments or agencies to develop the potential of teachers and trainers in the workplace.
